There is one bike rack outside of the venue.

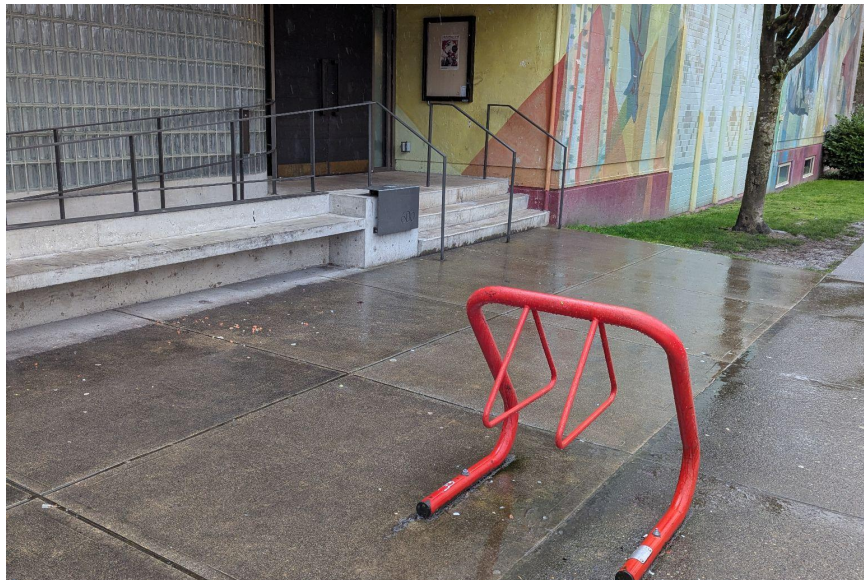
CAR

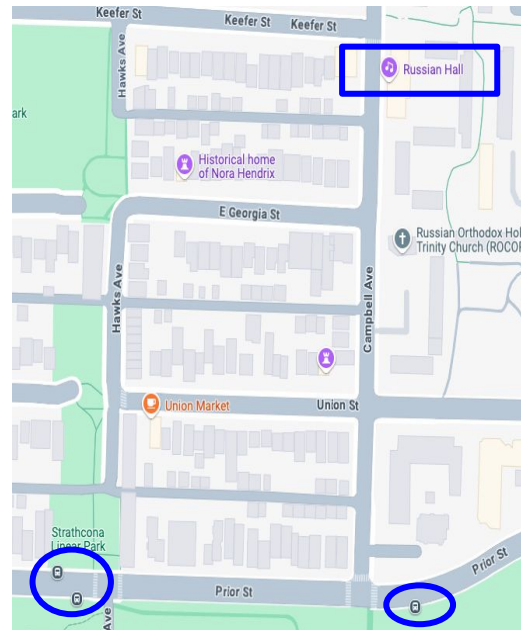
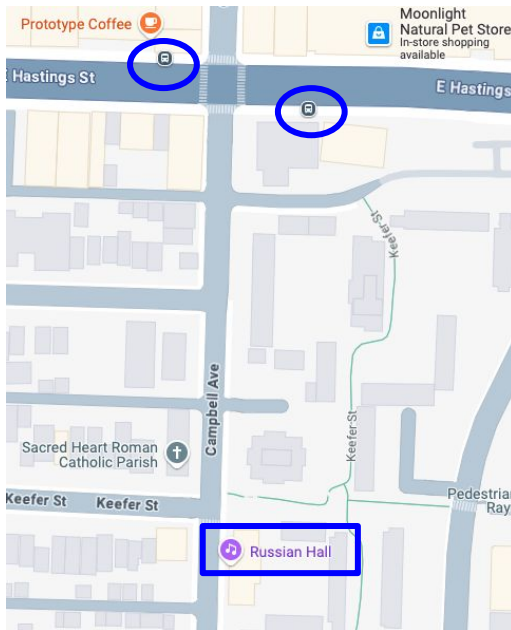
View routes on Google maps

of Hastings St. bus stop

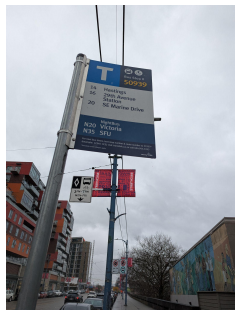


Turn right onto
Campbell

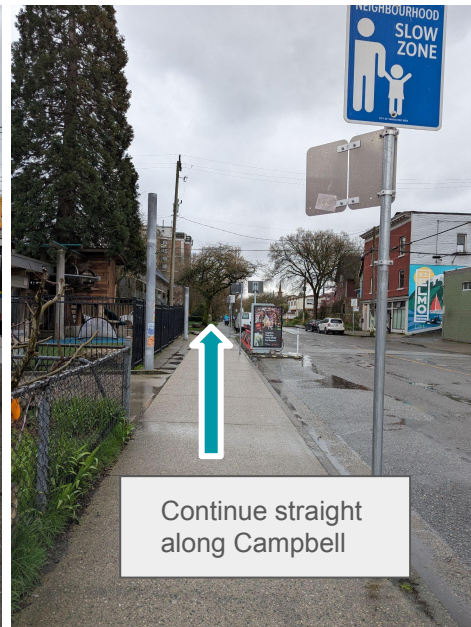
This is what the bus stop looks like on the northern side of

Campbell



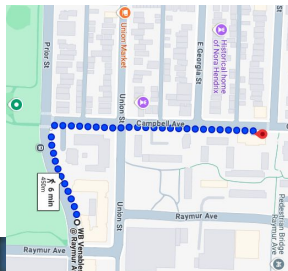
Continue straight

Accessibility of the Building

- There is a ramp to the front entrance
- There is an elevator to get down to the lower level, where the accessible washroom is located



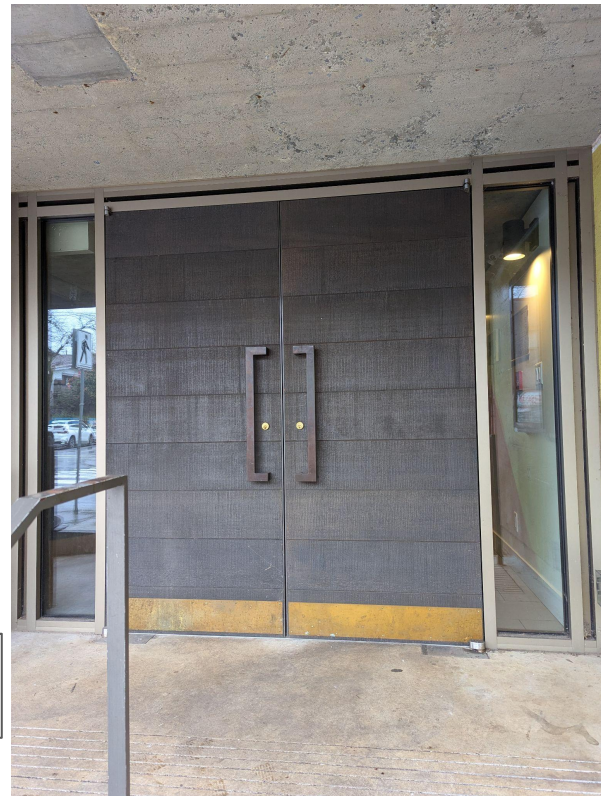
This is a picture of the ramp.

Things that make this building less accessible:

- There are no buttons to automatically open the front door or the accessible washroom door
- The concessions/bar counter is about 3 feet high
- The washrooms are gendered

Buying tickets

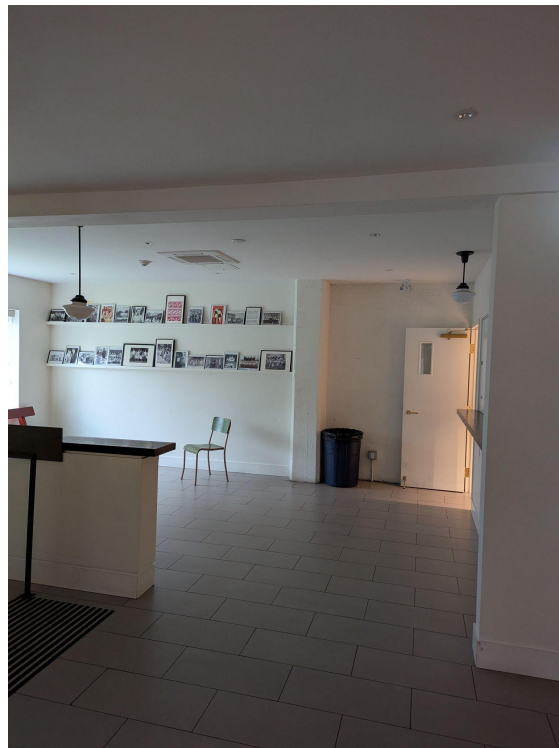


This is the lobby entrance. There will be a table where you can check in if you've purchased your tickets online.

The box office opens 30 minutes before the show begins. You can purchase tickets at the bar/concessions window.

This is what it looks like when you come inside.



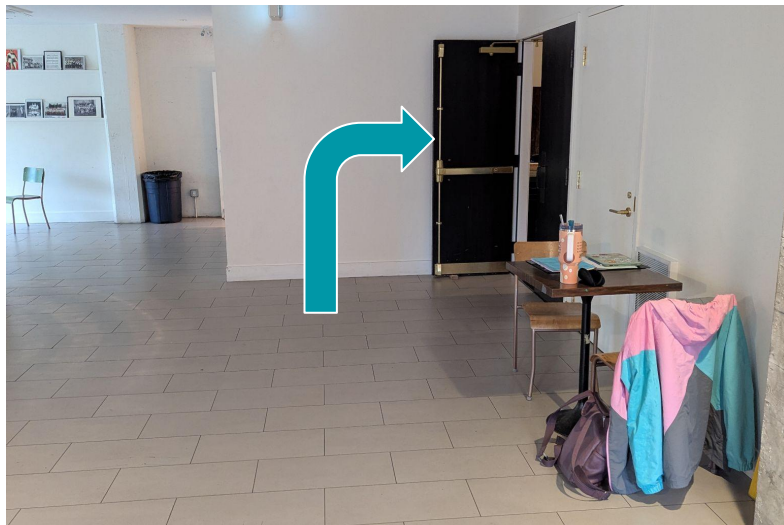
Drinks & Snacks

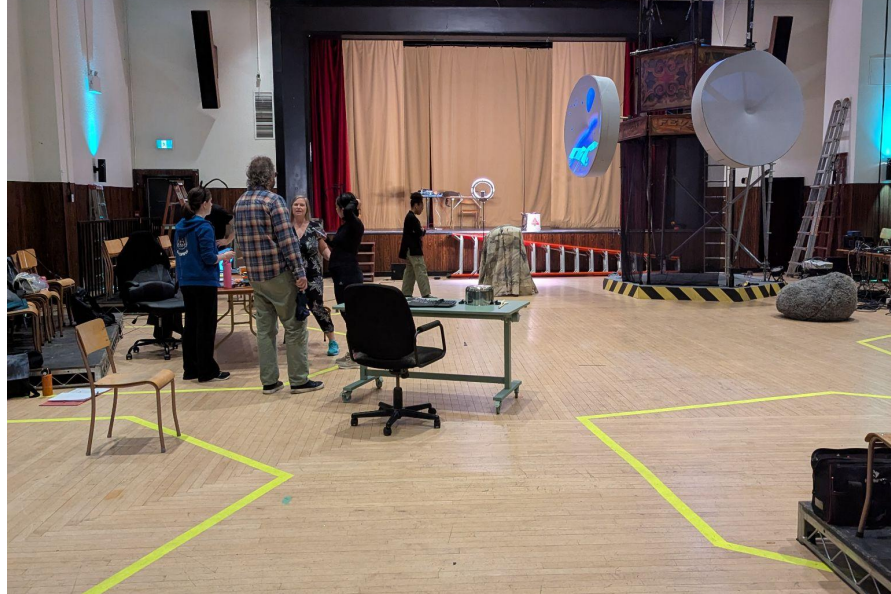

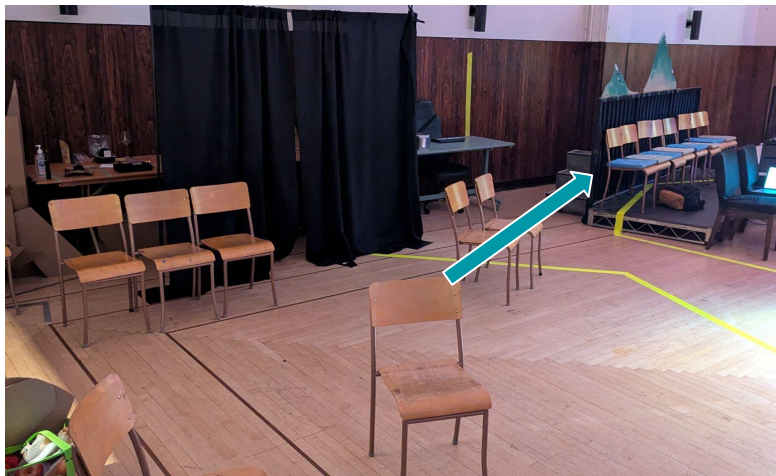
Inside the Theatre

The Chairs

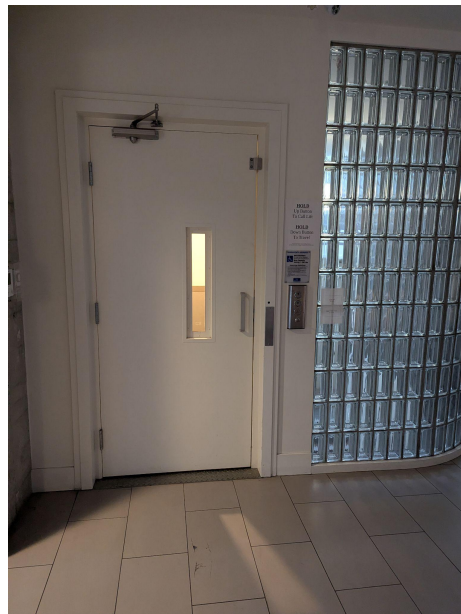
